



Certificate in English Language Studies Fees for International Students 2010

Overview

The Certificate in English Language Studies (CELS) course caters specifically for the English language needs of students who intend to enrol on the Bachelor of Business Studies in International Hotel Management programme. It is ideally suited to students who have attained the academic requirements for their chosen degree but who need to improve their spoken and written English.

Additional Expenses

Books/Materials:

CELS students will be provided with mandatory text books and study materials upon arrival at Shannon College. The approximate cost of these materials is €100.

IELTS Examination:

CELS students will sit an IELTS exam at the end of Semester 2. The fee for this exam was €182 in 2009 and may increase in 2010.

Health Insurance:

Health insurance is mandatory for visa purposes. Proof must be provided if a student already has health insurance. Otherwise health insurance must be paid with the CELS tuition fee. Health insurance is approx €120 per year.

Accommodation:

The College organises village style accommodation which is available to CELS students. The cost is €1,650 per academic semester for a single room. The accommodation is available from September to December (Semester 1) and January to May (Semester 2). There are 3 students per house, all with their own bathroom. CELS students have the option of taking college accommodation for one or two semesters or finding their own accommodation. Accommodation is payable by semester and is non-refundable.

Entry Requirements

CELS:

1. IELTS band level 5.0 or 5.5 (or equivalent)
2. Pass an entrance interview for CELS programme suitability

PROGRESS TO BBS:

1. Meet minimum academic requirements (to be provided with CELS application)
2. Pass an entrance interview for BBS programme suitability
3. Meet minimum of IELTS band level of 6.0 or equivalent (IELTS test taken at end of Semester 2)
