Note on Salaries:

A student is paid a salary by their placement hotel in Year 2 and at the End of Year 4. The salary in Year 2 is approx €17,500 per annum for placements in Ireland. In some cases, students may be paid less than this amount, but will receive subsidised accommodation from their placement hotel.

Students will receive a salary of approx €21,000 per annum for their final year Trainee Management Placement. The salary varies significantly from country to country depending on local wage rates; however the average salary in 2011 for final year placement students was €21,000.

College Charges in Year 1:

Accommodation	€3,300	The College organises village style accommodation for all first year students. The cost is €1,650 per academic semester for a single room. Three students share a three bedroom, three bathroom house.
Meal Charge	€400	As part of their education, Year 1 students are provided with lunch on Wednesdays and Thursdays during the 20 weeks of practical training (total of 40 meals). Each lunch is a three course meal. This is a compulsory charge for Year 1 students only.
Health Insurance	€120	Health insurance is mandatory for visa purposes. If a student already has health insurance, proof must be provided. Otherwise health insurance must be paid with the Year 1 fee. Health insurance is approx €120 per year.

Instalment Plan:

In Year 1, the tuition fee (€13,500), accommodation charge (€3,300) and meal charge (€400) amount to €17,200 and can be paid in two instalments. Similarly, tuition fees in Years 3 and 4 can be paid in two instalments. See adjacent table for the dates payments are due. The full health insurance charge of approx €120 is payable with the first instalment. The tuition fee for Year 2 is €2,000 and is payable by April 30th 2013 and is not payable in instalments.

Discount:

A discount of €200 is offered to students who pay the full Year 1 fee in one instalment. In this case, a fee of €17,000 (plus insurance) is payable on acceptance of a place in Year 1. The discount applies only to Year 1.

Other Year 1 Expenses (payable on arrival in Shannon):

Uniforms	Approx €480	Includes college business suit, restaurant uniform, chef uniform and kitchen safety shoes
Books	Approx €200	The students will have to buy mandatory texts for the Year 1. Students may be able to buy these books second hand which would help to reduce the cost.
